

Town of Mason Council
Special Meeting
Feb. 22, 2023, 6 p.m., Town Hall

The special meeting of the Mason Town Council was opened by Mayor Kristopher Clark with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

Present were Clark, Recorder Mindy Kearns, and council members Sarah Stover, Bob Reed, Jill Nelson, and Barry Taylor. Absent was Steve Ohlinger.

New Business:

It was noted four banks had been contacted regarding the lease/purchase of a new police car. Of the four, Farmers Bank was the only one to agree to the lease/purchase and provide a fixed interest rate of 5.75 percent.

Taylor made a motion, with Reed seconding, to accept the cost of the 2023 Dodge Durango from Mark Porter, at \$43,022, and to finance it through Farmers Bank. The motion passed unanimously.

Bills:

The council agreed to release the money received from the insurance company for the senior citizen building repair to Advanced Building and Remodeling, LLC. Stover made the motion, with a second by Taylor. The motion passed.

Details of the senior building remodel were explained to a couple in attendance, Woody and Paula Gregory.

The next regular meeting will be held March 9 at 6 p.m.
